CAMERA

A camera is a device that records image that can be stored directly, transmitted to another location, or both. These images may be still photography or moving images such as videos or movies. The term camera comes from the word camera obscura an early mechanism for projecting images. The modern camera evolved from the camera obscura.

Cameras may work with the light of the visible spectrum or with other portions of the electromagnetic spectrum. A camera generally consists of an enclosed hollow with an opening at one end for light to enter, and a recording or viewing surface for capturing the light at the other end. A majority of cameras have a lens positioned in front of the camera opening to gather the incoming light at the other end. And focus all or part of the image on the recording surface. Most cameras use an electronic image

sensors to store photography on flash memory. Other cameras, particularly the majority of cameras from the 20th century, use photographic film.

Washing Machine

A washing machine is a machine to wash laundry such as clothing and sheets. The term is mostly applied only to machines that use water as opposed to cleaning (which uses alternative cleaning fluids, and is performed by specialist businesses) or ultrasonic cleaners. Washing entails immersing, dipping, rubbing or scrubbing in water usually accompanied by detergent, or bleach. The simplest machines may simply agitate clothes in water while switched on: automatic machines may fill, empty, wash, spin, and heat in a cycle.

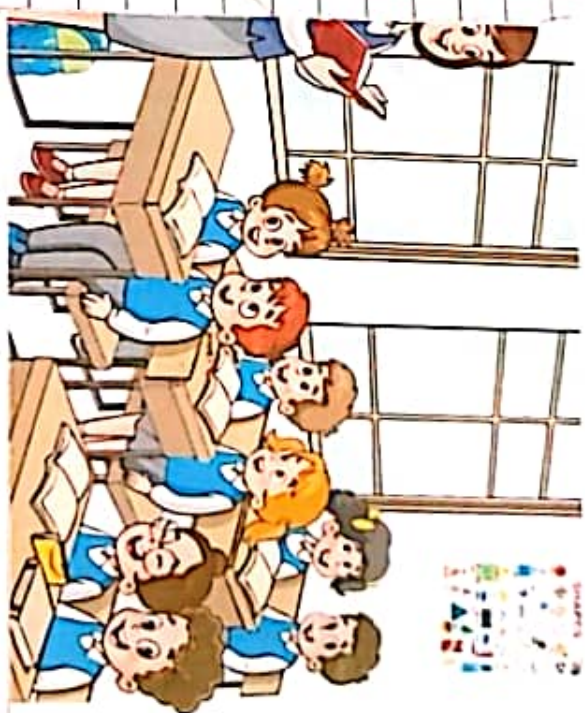

The classroom

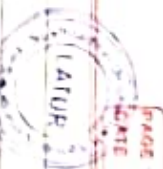

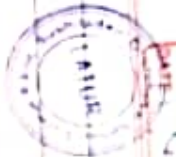


The Kitchen Table

- Person, place, thing or idea: "what or who"
- Nouns are **concrete** like dogs and cars.
- Or **abstract** like anger, liberty and friendship.
- **Common** like desks, puppies and mother.
- Or **proper** like Juanita, McAllen, HEB or Texas.

PRONOUN

- A pronoun is a short word that takes the place of a noun.
- Pronouns can be:
 - Subjects**: he or she
 - Objects**: him or her
 - Possessive**: his or hers
 - Indefinite**: nobody or all
 - Demonstrative**: this or those



VERB

- A verb tells what the noun does or is...

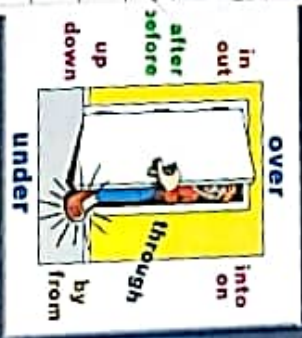
- Adjectives are descriptive words used to "modify" or tell more about nouns and pronouns...

child, his mother Hannah Ayscough
reportedly said that he could have
fit inside a quart mug. When Newton
was three his mother remarried and
went to live with her new husband,
the Reverend Barnabas Smith, leaving

500 in the care of his maternal
grandmother, Margery Ayscough Newton
disliked his stepfather and maintained
some enmity towards his mother for
marrying him, as revealed by his entry
in a list of sins committed up to the
age of 19. Threatening ray father and
mother smith to burn them and the
house over them Newton's mother
had three children (Mary Bennam
and Hannah) from her second marriage

4) Alexander III of Macedonia commonly known as Alexander the Great, was a king of the ancient Greek kingdom of Macedonia. He succeeded his father Philip II to the throne in 336 BC at the age of 20 and spent most of 30 he had created one of the largest empires in history stretching from Greece to northwestern India. He was undefeated in battle and is widely considered to be one of history's greatest and most successful military leadership over all Greeks in their conquest of Persia commanders.



With the age of 16 Alexander was tutored by Aristotle. In 335 BC shortly after his assumption of kingship over macedon, he campaigned in the Balkans and reasserted control over Thracian and parts of Illyria before marching on the city of Thebes, which was subsequently destroyed in battle. A Alexander then led the league of Corinthian and used his authority to launch the non-Hellenic project envisaged by his father assuming leadership over all Greeks in their conquest of Persia.
