




3.4.1 Outcome of extension activities in the neighbourhood community in terms of impact and sensitising the students to social issues for their holistic development during the last five years.

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3.4.1 Outcomes of Extension activities in the neighborhood community in terms of impact and sensitizing the students to social issues for their holistic development during the last five years.

Over the past five years, Smt. Sushiladevi Deshmukh Senior College, Latur, has consistently demonstrated its commitment to social responsibility and community engagement through a wide array of extension activities. These initiatives have been meticulously designed to address various social, health, cultural, and environmental issues within the neighborhood community. By involving students in these meaningful activities, the college has not only contributed significantly to community welfare but has also played a crucial role in sensitizing students to social issues, thereby promoting their holistic development. This report provides a detailed year-wise account of the extension activities carried out by the college from 2018 to 2023, highlighting their impact on the community and the transformative outcomes for the students involved.

In 2018, Smt. Sushiladevi Deshmukh Senior College initiated several impactful extension activities. The Sociology Abhyas Mandal's goodwill visit to the old age home helped students develop empathy and respect for the elderly, highlighting the importance of supporting and caring for senior citizens. The NSS Department organized a blood donation camp, which significantly contributed to local healthcare by providing much-needed blood supplies, while also instilling a sense of civic duty in the students. The Kerala Relief Fund Rally, also organized by the NSS, raised awareness and funds for the victims of the Kerala floods, fostering a spirit of solidarity and humanitarianism. Additionally, a social awareness program increased students' understanding of various social issues, promoting active community involvement. The Yuvati Mandal and NSS's goodwill visit to Mook Badhir Niwasi Vidyalaya sensitized students to the challenges faced by differently-abled individuals, encouraging inclusivity and support. Lastly, the AIDS Awareness Rally and Birth Anniversary Celebration educated the community about AIDS prevention and aimed to reduce stigma, promoting healthier lifestyles.

The year 2019 saw the continuation of impactful activities. The NSS and Political Science Department, in collaboration with the District Collector's Office, conducted an awareness campaign on EVM/VVPs for the Lok Sabha General Election. This initiative educated the public on the use of electronic voting machines,


enhancing democratic participation and electoral transparency. A goodwill visit to Samvedana Divyang School by the NSS Department and Geography Department promoted understanding and empathy towards differently-abled children. Blood donation camps organized by the NSS Department, including collaboration with the Alumni Association, continued to support local healthcare needs, reinforcing the culture of voluntary blood donation among students.

In 2021, the college's extension activities addressed both health and cultural aspects. The Matoshree Vyakhyanamala, organized by IQAC and NSS, featured a series of lectures that promoted intellectual and social awareness. The NSS Department's blood donation camps, including the Purna Din Blood Donation Camp, continued to save lives and encouraged regular donation practices. A COVID-19 vaccination camp under Mission Kavach-Kundal played a crucial role in combating the pandemic, increasing vaccination rates and promoting public health. The Marathi Rural Dialect Storytelling Session with Prof. Appasaheb Khot, organized by the Marathi Department, helped preserve and promote local culture, enriching students' cultural understanding.

The activities in 2022 were diverse and impactful. An online seminar on "कोरोना के बाद का मानव जीवन" (Human Life After COVID-19) organized by the Hindi Department, in collaboration with various institutions, provided insights into the post-COVID world, focusing on health, economy, and social aspects. The Sports Department's badminton tournament promoted physical fitness and sportsmanship. The Women Empowerment Cell's makeup artist training camp empowered women with practical skills for self-employment. An environment water soil conservation initiative by the NSS and the government raised awareness about environmental protection. Blood donation camps organized by the Alumni Association and NSS Department continued to support healthcare needs. The NSS and Political Science Department's campaign to connect voter ID with Aadhaar cards, along with a similar initiative by the Tehsil Office, streamlined administrative processes and increased civic participation. The Geography Day workshop on "Road Safety - Saving Life," organized by the Geography Department with the Regional Transport Office and State Road Safety Mission, promoted road safety awareness.

In 2023, the Geography Department continued its focus on road safety with the workshop "सडकसुरक्षा- जीवनरक्षा" (Road Safety - Saving Life), emphasizing the importance of safe driving practices and accident prevention. This initiative, in collaboration with the Regional Transport Office and State Road Safety Mission, educated students and the community on road safety measures, aiming to reduce accidents and save lives.

The extension activities conducted by Smt. Sushiladevi Deshmukh Senior College over the past five years have had a profound impact on the local community and have significantly contributed to the holistic development of students.
