What is ragging?

Ragging is a practice in educational institutions that evolves existing students baiting or bullying new students in the name of introduction or initiation, millions of students are brutally abused in many educational institutions. Historically originated, probably, to generate fellow feelings or camaraderie and the ability to work in a team. It has metamorphosed into something else. It often takes a malignant form where in the newcomers may be subjected to psychological or physical torture. Under the pretext of 'welcoming' new students to the college, ragging is a notorious practice that gives senior students an excuse to harass their Junior counterparts and make them easy targets to satiate there own perverse sadistic pleasure.

As defined by the Honorable Supreme Court of India- Any disorderly conduct weather by words spoken or written or by an act which has the effect of teasing, treating or handling with rudeness any other student indulging rowdy or undisciplined activities which causes or is likely to cause and annoyance, hardship or psychological or physical harm or to raise fear or generating

thereof in a fresher or a junior student and which has the effect of causing or generating sense of shame or embarrassment so as to adversely affect the psychic or psych of a fresher or a junior student.

How are students protected?

Today students can file a complaint against the person who has hurt him or her emotionally, physically or mentally with the anti- ragging cell that is set up in the college. One of the pre-emptive measures in our institution to curb ragging includes submission of undertaking by all students and their parents, at the time of admission, taking both not to Indulge in ragging.

What the students to do?

An Anti-Ragging Cell is set up comprising Principal, Chief Student Counsellor, Senior Faculty members and Staff. On the case of any ragging incident, the students may immediately call and bring it to the notice of the members of the Anti- Ragging Committee for necessary help, guidance and actions.

What will be the punishment for ragging?

Ragging within or outside the educational institution is prohibited. Whoever directly or indirectly commits, participates in, abets or instigates ragging inside or outside the educational institution shall be suspended, expelled or rusticated from the institution and shall also be liable to fine. The punishment includes rigorous in presentment, cancellation of admission, suspension from attending classes, withholding/ withdrawing fellowships, scholarships and other financial benefits withholding or cancelling the results.

We have separate committee for Anti-Ragging, students found guilty of ragging shall be penalize anyone or any combination of the following:

- a. Suspension from the college
- b. Withholding/withdrawal scholarship, Fellowship and other benefits.
- c. Forfeiting Campus Placement opportunities/ recommendations.
- d. Debarring from appearing in any test/examination or other evolution process.
- e. Withholding of results
- f. Cancellation of admission
- g. Rustication from the institution for a period, ragging from 1 to 3 years.
- h. Fine of rupees 5000/-

In addition, in case of every single incident of ragging, a First Information Report will be filed with the local police authorities.

College has also display the format of affidavit of anti-ragging.

Each student must submit and Undertaker/Affidavit of anti-ragging. This is the requirement of the regulations on prevention of ragging in India. These regulations were framed on an order of the Hon. Supreme Court in 2009. Students to fill their Undertaking/Affidavit by click on www website.
