- All the academic activities are monitored by the IQAC.
- The IQAC issues regular notices & directions to all the heads of the departments regarding the curriculum.
- Various classroom teaching methods based on various needs of different subjects will be regularly used for the effective delivery of the curriculum such as:

1. PPT Presentation
2. ICT-enabled teaching-learning method
3. Chalk and talk method.
4. Use of scientific models and charts
5. Conduct of periodical internal examinations.
6. Group discussion in the classroom.

7. Seminars by the student related to the curriculum.

8. Field work/project work/ visits and education tours

- IQAC asks to the heads and teachers of all subjects to finalise the Course Outcomes (COs), Program Outcomes (POs) and Program Specific Outcomes (PSOs), display the same on the college website, notice boards and on social media platforms like WhatsApp gr.) of the classes.
